FEDERAL POWER RESERVE DOCUMENTATION

POWERSITE CLASSIFICATION NO. 9

SECRETARIAL ORDER

Alaska No. 1
Cascade Creek and Thomas Bay.

Under and pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1875 (20 Stat. 394) I hereby classify as powersites the lands hereinafter described, in so far as title thereto remains in the United States and recommend that this classification be given full force and effect under Section 24 of the Act of Congress approved June 10, 1920 (41 Stat., 1063).

Unsurveyed lands in Alaska situated in latitude about 57° N., and longitude about 132° 45' W. from Greenwich and described as follows:

(a) Lands along Cascade Creek, from its mouth on Thomas Bay upstream about 2 1/2 miles to the outlet of a large unnamed lake, above Flat Lakes, including all lands on the south side of the creek and within 1/8 mile thereof and all lands on the north side of the Creek and within 1/3 mile thereof.

(b) All lands in the drainage basin of Cascade Creek upstream from and not more than 150 feet higher than the stream-bed elevation of said lake outlet.

(c) All lands on the south side of Cascade Creek between the contours respectively 50 feet below and 150 feet above the stream bed elevation of said lake from the said lake outlet to a point 1.2 miles therefrom where said contours turn sharply away from Thomas Bay and run in a southeasterly direction and are shown on the map to be 4,000 feet from the nearest point of the creek.

(d) All lands within 750 feet of a line beginning at a point on the shore of Thomas Bay 4,400 feet S. about 41° W., from the mouth of Cascade Creek and running thence S. 63° E. about 3,750 feet to a junction with the contour 50 feet below the stream-bed elevation of the said lake outlet; and

(e) All lands within 1/8 mile of Thomas Bay south of and within 1 1/8 miles of the mouth of Cascade Creek, all as shown approximately on the accompanying blueprint map entitled Powersite Classification No. 9.

POWER SITE CLASSIFICATION NO. 192

Alaska No. 7

Streams and Lakes of Southeastern Alaska.

Under and pursuant to the provisions of the act of Congress approved March 3, 1879 (20 Stat., 394), I hereby classify as power sites the lands hereinafter described, in so far as title thereto remains in the United States, and recommend that this classification be given full force and effect under Section 24 of the act of Congress approved June 10, 1920 (41 Stat., 1063):

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Shelokum Lake and the stream which is its outlet, located approximately in lat. $55^{\circ} 59' N.$, and long. $131^{\circ} 38' W.$

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Lake Reflection, located approximately in lat. $55^{\circ} N.$, long. $131^{\circ} 31' W.$

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Short Creek, the outlet of Lake Reflection.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of East Fork of Short Creek from its mouth to a point $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles upstream.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Punchbowl Lake, located approximately in lat. $55^{\circ} 31' N.$, and long. $130^{\circ} 45' W.$

Power Site Classification No. 192 - 2

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unnamed stream which is the outlet of Punchbowl Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Humpback Lake located approximately in lat. $55^{\circ} 61' N.$, and long. $130^{\circ} 40' W.$

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unnamed stream which is the outlet of Humpback Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Salmon Lake and Little Salmon Lake, located on the east side of Prince of Wales Island.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within 1 mile of Karta River, the outlet of Little Salmon Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Lake Josephine, Lake Mellen, and Summit Lake located on the west coast of Prince of Wales Island east of Hetta Inlet.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unnamed stream which drains Summit Lake into Lake Mellen.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Reynolds Creek, the outlet of Lake Mellen.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unnamed stream having its source in a small unnamed lake located about one-third mile south of Lake Josephine and emptying into Lake Mellen.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Claude Lake, located on the north end of Revillagigedo Island.

Power Site Classification No. 192. - 3

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of East Fork of Claude Creek, the outlet of Claude Lake, and within one-fourth mile of Claude Creek below its junction with East Fork.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Manzanita Creek (located on the east coast of Revillagigedo Island) from its mouth to a point 1 mile upstream.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unsurveyed lake located about half a mile inland from tidewater on the west side of Hidden Inlet, a branch of Portland Canal, and also every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of a stream which is the outlet of this lake entering Hidden Inlet in lat. $54^{\circ} 58'$ N., and long. $130^{\circ} 21\frac{1}{2}'$ W.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of McHenry Lake, located in the southwestern part of Etolin Island, about 8000 feet northeast from the head of McHenry Inlet, and every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of a stream which is the outlet of McHenry Lake entering McHenry Inlet in lat. $56^{\circ} 2'$ N., and long. $132^{\circ} 22\frac{1}{2}'$ W.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of White River, tributary to Bradfield Canal from its mouth in approximately lat. $56^{\circ} 14'$ N., and long. $131^{\circ} 34'$ W., to the junction of the two main forks of the river about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles above its mouth.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Harding River, tributary to Bradfield Canal, from its mouth in approximately lat. $56^{\circ} 13'$ N., and long. $131^{\circ} 38'$ W., to a point 10 miles upstream.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within 1 mile of the mouth of Tom Creek, tributary to Bradfield Canal.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Cascade Creek, tributary to Thomas Bay from Swan Lake to its mouth in approximately lat. $57^{\circ} 0'$ N., and long. $132^{\circ} 47'$ W.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Swan Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Anan Creek, from the point where it enters Humpback Bay approximately in lat. $56^{\circ} 11'$ N., and long. $131^{\circ} 53'$ W., to an unnamed lake located about 2 miles above Anan Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of Anan Lake.

Every smallest legal subdivision which, when surveyed, will lie within one-fourth mile of an unnamed lake located about 2 miles above Anan Lake and draining into Anan Lake.

INTERPRETATION NO. 174
of
Power-Site Classification No. 9, Alaska No. 1
and
Power-Site Classification No. 192, Alaska No. 7
Cascade Creek Basin, Alaska

It is hereby ordered that so much of the orders of August 20, 1921, creating Power-Site Classification No. 9, and November 14, 1927, creating Power-Site Classification No. 192, as described lands with reference to Cascade Creek or its tributary, Swan Lake, Alaska, be construed to describe the following areas:

TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST

In Power-Site Classification No. 9

All lands below the 1,050 foot contour above sea level which drain into Swan Lake, located in the Cascade Creek Basin about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles inland from the east shore of Thomas Bay, Alaska; all lands south of Cascade Creek within one mile of the middle of said creek, and all lands north of Cascade Creek within one-eighth of a mile of the middle of said creek, extending from Swan Lake to the shore of Thomas Bay. Mouth of creek is in approximately Lat. 57° N., Long. $132^{\circ} 47'$ W.
